Property Tax Reimbursement

The deadline for the Property Tax Reimbursement application has been extended to November 1, 2010. The income limits for all applicants is \$70,000 for both 2008 and 2009. In addition to the income limits the following are required:

- 1) Must be 65 as of December 31, 2008.
- 2) Must live in New Jersey continuously for the past 10 years.
- 3) Must have owned and lived in your home for the last 3 years.
- 4) Must have property taxes paid in full.

First time applicants will not receive a reimbursement this year but will establish 2008 as their base year for future applications. For assistance in filing this form call Jim Dong at 732-390-6809. Information about this program may also be obtained by logging on
