A late pick-up penalty of \$10 per 15 minutes will be assessed; payable in cash or check before the start of the next camp day. If no contact can be made for person(s) responsible for pick-up of camper, the camper will be transported in a township vehicle to the Recreation Office.

**An Extended Care Form will be mailed with your receipt.**

### **Group Placement**

*Camp is a wonderful place to make new friends!* Parents may request placement of a camper in a group with **one** friend - the request must be mutual. Campers must be in the same grade and at the same camp site. The Site Director has the final decision in group placement. This is done for Kool Kids and Super Stars **ONLY**.

### **Administration of Medication**

No medication (prescription or non-prescription) may be brought to camp or dispensed at camp. The **only** exception is epinephrine and inhalers. Permission to administer must be part of the camper's record. All medication must be in the original container clearly marked with the child's name and pharmacy label with doctor's instructions. Inhalers or epi-pen forms must be accompanied with directions and permission to administer by staff in an emergency. This form will be sent to you on an as needed basis.

### **Insurance Information**

There is no medical insurance coverage included in camp registration. By participating, you assume your own medical insurance responsibilities.

### **Toileting**

Children must be able to toilet independently. Staff does not assist with toileting or changing a child's clothing. If a child has a toileting accident, the parent(s) will be called. If they continue to have toileting accidents they will be removed from the program.

The Division of Recreation Summer Day Camp is a co-ed camp serving children in grades K-9. The camp provides a variety of experiences that support social and physical growth in a positive environment in which children have the opportunity to explore, play, learn from adult role models, develop self confidence, use their imagination, and develop new friendships. The program stimulates exploration and adventure through individual and group activities while developing insight into cooperation and decision making. Amazing trips, sports, arts & crafts, swimming, games and creative activities promote an exhilarating summer for each camper.

Our camp is where camper's personal, emotional, and physical needs are nurtured by staff that has a great love of children. This camp will give you the peace of mind that your child is in a caring environment this summer.

Our camp is accredited by the American Camp Association (ACA) which recognizes camps for providing quality programming with the health and safety of campers and staff in the forefront. Standards established by ACA provide guidelines for policies, procedures, and practices, as well as education and evaluation to ensure the ongoing challenging and nurturing aspects of the program.

All camp programs are held in various East Brunswick public schools. A majority of the schools are not air conditioned. The Division of Recreation reserves the right to set a minimum/maximum number of campers per site. Registrants may be assigned to other camp sites when the maximum number of campers is reached. Summer Camp sites are subject to change due to the availability of the schools.

Each site is directed by a licensed teacher, certified in First Aid and CPR. Assisting the director are experienced adult specialists (also certified in First Aid and CPR) who create arts & crafts and games & activities to meet the interests of the campers.

All costs for camp activities are included in the registration fee unless otherwise specified. Campers bring their own lunches and snacks. Transportation is provided for off-site activities only. Camp shirts are also provided and must be worn every day. For campers who choose NOT to participate in excursions, no alternative programming or staffing on site can be provided. Families will be responsible for arranging appropriate options/care on those days.

Camp registrations will be accepted and processed on a first come, first served basis only when they are received through the U.S. Postal Service postmarked no earlier than February 8, 2010\* and accompanied by full payment or the initial deposit as specified in the full and half day camp program charts (see p. 6 and 7). Any registration bearing an incorrect postmark, an incorrect payment or initial deposit, or **incomplete forms will be returned to sender.** We DO NOT accept registrations via FAX, phone, email, or in-person – through the mail only.



A receipt will be mailed confirming the program in which the camper is registered. If the program is full, the camper's name will be placed on a Wait List and the registration and check returned (see p. 5 for Wait List information).

The Counselor-in-Training program is an opportunity for younger teens to learn the responsibilities of becoming a Day Camp Counselor. CITs will be responsible for assisting in the daily activities of the site. **CITs must be available for the entire six week camp session and are required to attend all orientation sessions, instructional sessions, and staff meetings as scheduled by the Division of Recreation and the Day Camp Site/CIT Coordinators.** Special trips and activities will be planned throughout the program to combine a summer of learning with a summer of fun. Admissions for these trips is included in the registration fee, along with five (5) staff t-shirts. *\*Returning CITs will be assigned to Hammarskjold Middle School.*

## REGISTRATION POLICIES

**PROOF OF RESIDENCY** - Must be submitted every time you register for a recreation program. The following will be accepted - send only one (1) required proof:

Valid Driver's License • Apartment Lease • Mortgage Payment Bill • Current Utility Bill

**RESIDENT** - A resident is a participant who lives within East Brunswick Township and may register during the Early Registration or General Registration period.

**NON-RESIDENT REGISTRATION** - A non-resident is a participant who lives outside of East Brunswick. A Middlesex County resident may register beginning March 15 for a fee that is 1.5 times the Early Registration resident fee. For example, if a resident fee is \$200, the non-resident fee will be \$300. Non-residents must pay the full fee at time of registration. Please see below for non-resident definitions:

### **REGISTRATION DATES FOR NON-RESIDENTS -**

- Middlesex County Residents can begin registering March 15
- NJ state residents and out of state residents can register May 4
- Registration deadline for all participants is June 16

**AGE REQUIREMENTS**- Participants must meet the required age or grade level as of September 2010 as specified in camp program descriptions.

**PROOF OF AGE** - Proof of Age is required for first-time registrants ONLY. Submit a COPY of your child's birth certificate (or other legal documentation verifying age).

**REFUNDS** - All payments are fully refundable until May 3, 2010. After May 3 all payments are non-refundable. Refunds will be issued only if a program is cancelled. A refund form must be completed and returned to the Division of Recreation.

**SUMMER ACADEMY** – Parents of children eligible for the East Brunswick Public School's Summer Academy Program will be notified of their child's eligibility by April 30, 2010. Should you decide to enroll your child in the Summer Academy Program he/she will be unable to attend the East Brunswick Township Summer Day Camp program due to conflicts in daily scheduling.

The Division of Recreation has coordinated the following refund policy with the School District:

Refunds due to Summer Academy enrollment will only be issued before May 14, 2010 when accompanied by an original letter stating such from E.B. Public Schools. No refunds will be issued after May 14. For information on the School Districts fee based afternoon enrichment program please contact the School District's Community Programs Department at 732-613-6982.

**WAIT LIST** - You will be contacted **only** if a space becomes available and be given a date by which to pay the fee and complete the registration process. If payment is not received by the requested date, the opening will be offered to the next person on the Wait List. If placed on the Wait List prior to May 3, a Wait List registrant shall pay the Early Registration fee.
