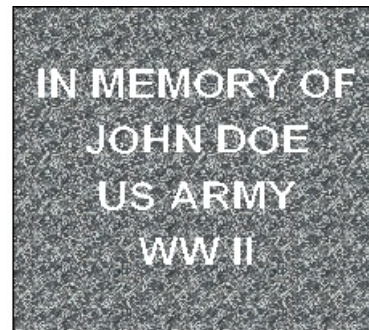
On May 26, 1996, the East Brunswick Veterans Monument was dedicated at the Township's annual Memorial Day Ceremony. Built to honor the men and women who served our country in the military, the monument is located in Veterans Park on the grounds of the Civic Center and features a sloped entry monument, a waving black granite flag, and six side monuments representative of each military division. The entire area is surrounded by beautiful seasonally landscaped gardens making it a major focal point in our community.

In response to a continued interest by residents to purchase pavers and be part of this special park, the Township continues to sell granite pavers to be added to the walkway; the pavers are dedicated at the annual Memorial Day and Veterans Day observances.



The site also features a paved walkway leading up to the monument that is lined with 244 black granite pavers bearing personal inscriptions from private individuals and businesses who have chosen to be part of this tribute to veterans.

For a \$300 donation, you can have a black granite paver measuring 4" x 4" inscribed with your name, that of a loved one, or even your business installed along the VETERANS WALK OF HONOR making it a permanent and lasting part of the community. If you visit the site, you will see that supporters may have chosen to recognize someone who served in the military, or in memory of a fallen veteran, or simply as a benefactor. Once thing is for sure, all supporters have experienced a tremendous pride in being a part of East Brunswick's tribute to veterans.
