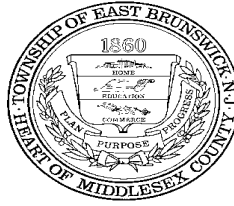

**INTRODUCED: JANUARY 9, 2023**

**AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK IN ACCORDANCE (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14) FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council of East Brunswick in the County of Middlesex finds it advisable and necessary to increase its Calendar Year (CY) 2023 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$1,835,917.26 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council of East Brunswick in the County of Middlesex hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of East Brunswick in the County of Middlesex of the Township of East Brunswick, in the County of Middlesex a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2023 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of East Brunswick shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$1,835,917.26, and that the CY 2023 municipal budget for the Township of East Brunswick be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote, included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

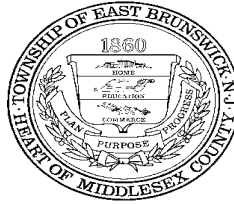

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST BRUNSWICK, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 209, SECTION 40, ENTITLED “SCHEDULE I: NO PARKING,” OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST BRUNSWICK TO CHANGE CERTAIN PARKING REGULATIONS ON EDGEBORO ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Township to impose parking restrictions on Edgeboro Road to ensure the safety of the public as a result of recent changes in traffic patterns that have led to traffic obstruction.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of East Brunswick in the State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 209 of the Code of the Township of East Brunswick, Section §209-40, thereof, entitled “Schedule I: No Parking”, is hereby amended to add the following:

**§ 209-40 Schedule I: No Parking**

In accordance with the provisions of §209-40, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon the following described streets or parts of streets:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Township, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of the Ordinances of the Township are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.

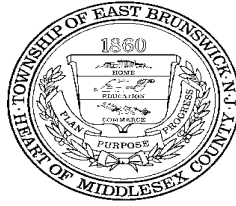

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST BRUNSWICK, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 209, SECTION 65, ENTITLED “SCHEDULE XXVI: MID-BLOCK CROSSINGS,” OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST BRUNSWICK TO ADD A MID-BLOCK CROSSWALK DESIGNATION ON EDGEBORO ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Township to add a Mid-Block Crosswalk designation on Edgeboro Road to ensure the safety of pedestrians.

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of the Township of East Brunswick in the State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 209 of the Code of the Township of East Brunswick, Section §209-65, thereof, entitled “Schedule XXVI: Mid-Block Crossings”, is hereby amended to add the following:

**§ 209-65 Schedule XXVI: Mid-Block Crossings**

The following mid-block crossings are hereby authorized for pedestrian use at the locations indicated:
