Submission Guidelines

Semester Application Periods

Spring Semester: October 1st - December 1st

Summer Semester: March 1st - May 1st

Fall Semester: June 1st - August 1st

Winter Semester: Not Accepted

All Internship Applicants must follow the below guidelines:

- 1) Completed application
- 2) Current resume
- 3) Submission to modified background check
- 4) Official letter from College/University Internship Coordinator demonstrating approval for enrollment in internship and required hours.
- 5) Copy of school insurance rider for coverage
- 6) Applicants must not have any previous criminal convictions
- 7) Completed application must be submitted in person to the Internship Coordinator
- 8) Applicants must adhere to internship schedule after it has been finalized. Interns calling out, and frequent no shows without prior notice, will not be tolerated and will be grounds for termination of the internship
