Critical Infrastructure Resilience and Community Lifelines (MGT-414)

The New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness will sponsor multiple sessions of a one-day training course titled, “Critical Infrastructure Resilience and Community Lifelines” (MGT-414). The Texas Engineering Extension Service, a member of the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium, will deliver the course. There is **no-cost** to attend this course.

Description

In this course participants will learn how to develop a roadmap for progress toward the National Preparedness Goal by facilitating the development of resilience considerations and involving essential community critical infrastructure partners. Participants will learn how to formulate considerations for the resilience of community assets that leverage cross-sector partnerships. These considerations enhance the whole community’s ability to manage the risk associated with critical infrastructure protection efforts. Participants will have an opportunity to practice the practical skills necessary to formulate considerations in the local community.

Audience

This course is for participants interested in obtaining the TEEX Infrastructure Protection Certificate. The certificate is for professionals who wish to enrich their personal knowledge and skills related to critical infrastructure security and resilience. Participants can request to receive a certificate once all four courses (AWR-213, MGT-310, MGT-315, and MGT-414) are completed.
