Critical Infrastructure Security and Resilience Awareness (AWR-213)

The New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness will sponsor multiple sessions of a one-day training course titled, “Critical Infrastructure Security and Resilience Awareness” (AWR-213). The Texas Engineering Extension Service, a member of the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium, will deliver the course. There is **no-cost** to attend this course.

Description

This course will introduce participants to the key terms, policy, guidance, and preparedness efforts required to safeguard the Nation’s critical infrastructure. Participants will discuss the risk management framework, describe Federal critical infrastructure security and resilience and information sharing programs, and relate critical infrastructure programs to individual actions. Focus will be placed on local preparedness efforts as they relate to the national approach to critical infrastructure security and resilience, enabling stakeholders to address local planning within a common framework. Informed planning is consistent with accepted emergency management standards as the basis for planning across the mission areas of prevention, protection, mitigation, response, and recovery.

Audience

This course is for participants interested in obtaining the TEEX Infrastructure Protection Certificate. The certificate is for professionals who wish to enrich their personal knowledge and skills related to critical infrastructure security and resilience. Participants can request to receive a certificate once all four courses (AWR-213, MGT-310, MGT-315, and MGT-414) are completed.
