Your animal license must be renewed by March 31st. Please comply in order to avoid a late fee and a summons.

ATTENTION PET OWNERS

All dogs and cats seven (7) months of age or older and kept in the Township of East Brunswick for more than ten (10) days are required to be licensed; and the issued tag should be worn by said animal. Failure to obtain a valid animal license can result in a fine in accordance with Township Code Section 83-33.

All animal licenses are for the calendar year, January 1st through December 31st. All license renewals must be received by March 31st of the licensing year. Postmarks are not acceptable.

ALL RENEWALS RECEIVED AFTER MARCH 31ST OF THE LICENSING YEAR ARE SUBJECT TO A \$5.00 LATE FEE.

All applications and/or renewals for animal licenses should be remitted to the Township by mail only, along with a check or money order made payable to the Township of East Brunswick.

Proof of rabies vaccination and spaying/neutering is required for all new licenses. Proof of new vaccines must accompany renewals.

PET LICENSING Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:23A-4.2, to issue a dog license, the pet owner must first supply to the dog licensing clerk a rabies vaccination certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian indicating that the animal's duration of immunity extends throughout at least the first ten months of the twelvemonth licensing period. Animals that have a duration of immunity which expires prior to the ten-month cut-off (between January 1st and October 31st) must receive a booster rabies vaccination prior to licensure. Boostering the animal's immunity before expiration of the previous vaccination has not been associated with an increased occurrence of adverse reactions.

Failure to provide the appropriate documentation and/or fee will result in your application/renewal being returned unprocessed.
